Baltic Sea Region EUSBSR

The European Union Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region (EUSBSR) is a cooperation of 12 countries.

They work together to save the Baltic Sea, connect the region and increase prosperity; amongst others by fostering climate change adaptation and ensure better coordination of the fight against cross-border crime.



Danube Region EUSDR

The Danube Region is a highly multilateral cooperation of 14 countries, including also candidates for EU accession.

The EU Strategy for the Danube Region (EUSDR) targets environmental protection such as the joint management of water quality of the Danube river, sustainable establishment of common infrastructure as well as preservation of joint cultural heritage, amongst others.



Adriatic-Ionian Region EUSAIR

The Strategy for the Adriatic-Ionian Region (EUSAIR) was developed to foster synergies amongst 8 countries surrounding the Adriatic-Ionian Sea.

The objectives endorsed by the EUSAIR focus on blue growth, transport & energy networks, environmental quality and sustainable tourism.



Alpine Region EUSALP

The Strategy for the Alpine Region (EUSALP) is a joint initiative of 7 Alpine countries.

Based on the 3 priorities growth & innovation, mobility & connectivity and environment & energy, the EUSALP targets the strengthening of the region by jointly tackling Alpine-specific challenges. Together, the Alpine countries seize opportunities for sustainable and innovative development in a European context.
