Avoid immediate request for changes


Not possible in the first 6 months project lifetime

3 Ensure early start

Contribute to the avoidance of de-commitment

Implementation Seminar shall be organized at a later date

Negotiation timetable



Project implementation

Start asap in accordance with set defined date

6 months' reporting periods

First payment procedures start

Upon condition of finalization of the legal framework

Advance payment to IPA beneficiaries (10% IPA funds)

Request for payment of preparation costs (through ad hoc template)



9 December 2019

Deadline for revision of project proposals: correctly uploaded on eMS; all attachments available and updated if necessary; technical approval by JS provided eMS available for AF revision as from 10 October

End December 2019

Communication to MC; information on final budget; Information on those projects which have not fulfilled the set requirements

Finalization of the legal framework

Subsidy contract and partnership agreement templates sent Signature asap and no later than the deadline reported in the official accompanying letter

Available documentation

Start reading available documentation to ensure early project implementation

Revision mainly based on first call experience and novelties included in the programme manual 2nd call
