Building the "capital" of the Programme: the knowledge based at projects' level including good practices, outputs and policy experiences. In addition, ADRION Capitalisation aims to shed light on future territorial needs and potentials in the Programme area.

Objectives

- Increase impact of project results
- Increase raising awareness
- Enhance future ADRION positioning


Coastal and Marine Environment management



It includes the necessary elements to handle the management of coastal and marine spaces in an integrated way: preservation/protection of biodiversity; risk prevention and disaster resilience; pollution diffusion and waste management; sustainable blue economy growth support.

ADRION Thematic Clusters: envisaged activities

Capitalization activities can be chosen among those of the following menu:

- 1. Organization and actively participation to at least 3 Thematic Cluster meetings with the involvement of all projects involved in that Thematic Cluster;
- 2. Participation to the ADRION Annual Event in 2020 and/or ADRION capitalization events
- 3. Contribution to the update of the new ADRION web section on Thematic Cluster;
- 4. Organization of at least 1 macro-regional event for the dissemination of Thematic Cluster outcomes and potentials; and/or at least 1 joint stakeholders' meeting addressing common interest;
- 5. Elaboration of a **joint brochure and /or report on the outcomes** of Thematic Cluster activities **and its potentials**;
- 6. Elaboration of **specific analysis in the fields/sectors/ themes covered** by the specific Thematic Cluster **and/or position paper/policy paper / recommendations for influencing the policy debate** in the theme of the Thematic Cluster
- 7. Identification /elaboration of project ideas to be financed in the framework of the next programming period;
- 8. Extension/widening the existing created networks;
- **9. Widening the scope of the planned outputs, as result of cross-fertilization activities performed** (e.g. revision of the project strategy/action plan considering the new multidisciplinary approach).



How to proceed: Thematic Cluster level

1. Participate the Programme Capitalization and Programme Event in 2020.

Meet the current Thematic Clusters implemented by 1st call funded projects in order to establish preliminary contacts and verify potential synergies. JS shall inform 1st call projects accordingly.

2. Identify their Thematic Cluster /sub- Thematic Cluster.

Select the activities to be implemented in the framework of the above pre-defined list.

Beginning of February 2021

3. Propose as coordinators of a new Thematic Cluster or be part of already constituted Thematic Cluster.

Coordination role shall in any case be transferred after 1st call projects closure.

Beginning of February 2021

4. Thematic Clusters are encouraged to envisage the involvement of relevant stakeholders along their activities to ensure the creation of synergies and added value beyond what already achieved.

How to proceed: project level

Continuation of Thematic Clusters activities

Thematic Cluster

- Identify the Thematic Cluster and your possible engagement (participant/coordinator)
- Inform the JS about
- The JS shall inform all projects about and facilitate projects meetings

Beginning of February 2021

Planned activities

 Projects shall inform the JS on the joint activities they intend to implement within the Thematic Cluster, the timeline and envisaged budget, which project does what and eventual need of action plan revision

Beginning of March 2021

How to proceed

- No additional funds envisaged, but financial resources already included in your application (ref to 21.4.2 of the Programme manual)
- Based on the decisions above, each project shall proceed with a revision of its work plan, if necessary: minor or major changes shall occur
- Update of the Subsidy Contract and Partnership Agreement if necessary
