- ❑ Identification of new areas/fields of intervention for the future programming period;
- ❑ Increase the project's visibility, promoting them in a more strategic way;
- ❑ Increase of transferability of project results beyond the single project partnership.

Criteria for the definition of the ADRION Clusters

- ❑ **Strategic key areas** of the Adriatic – Ionian Region;
- ❑ **Topics** addressed by the **current funded projects**;
- ❑ **Relevant** project's **critical mass** within a specific topic/area of intervention;
- ❑ **Link** with the **policy objectives** and related specific objectives of the **new Cohesion Policy** (*a Smarter Europe; a Greener, carbon free Europe; a more Connected Europe; a more Social Europe; a Europe closer to citizens*).

Thematic Cluster structure

- Projects are free to decide whether to participate or not in the Thematic Clusters, even though their engagement is strongly recommended by the Programme;
- In case not all project partners are interested in participating in Capitalization activities, not interested partners shall simply not be involved;
- Each Thematic Cluster must **appoint a Coordinator** – that will be in charge of liaising with the JS on behalf of the entire Thematic Cluster;
- Each Thematic Cluster must be composed by **at least 3 projects**;
- Thematic Cluster must be considered as "**open communities**";
- Thematic Cluster must be also **open to synergies outside the Adriatic – Ionian Community** and other ETC programmes or projects funded by other funding schemes, including mainstream programmes.

Resources to support Capitalization activities

- **"Savings"** produced at project level are the main source of funding;
- It is possible to shift resources among partners benefitting from the same source of co-financing, maintaining **ERDF and IPA overall amount unchanged**;
- **Estimation** of the necessary resources at **Thematic Cluster** level:
 - Compulsory activities (No.1+2+3) - up to **EUR 60.000**
 - Additional two activities among those listed from 4 to 9 - up to **EUR 90.000**

Up to max. EUR 150.000
- In case, projects demonstrate high interest in capitalization activities, MC will be informed and may decide to allocate additional resources.
