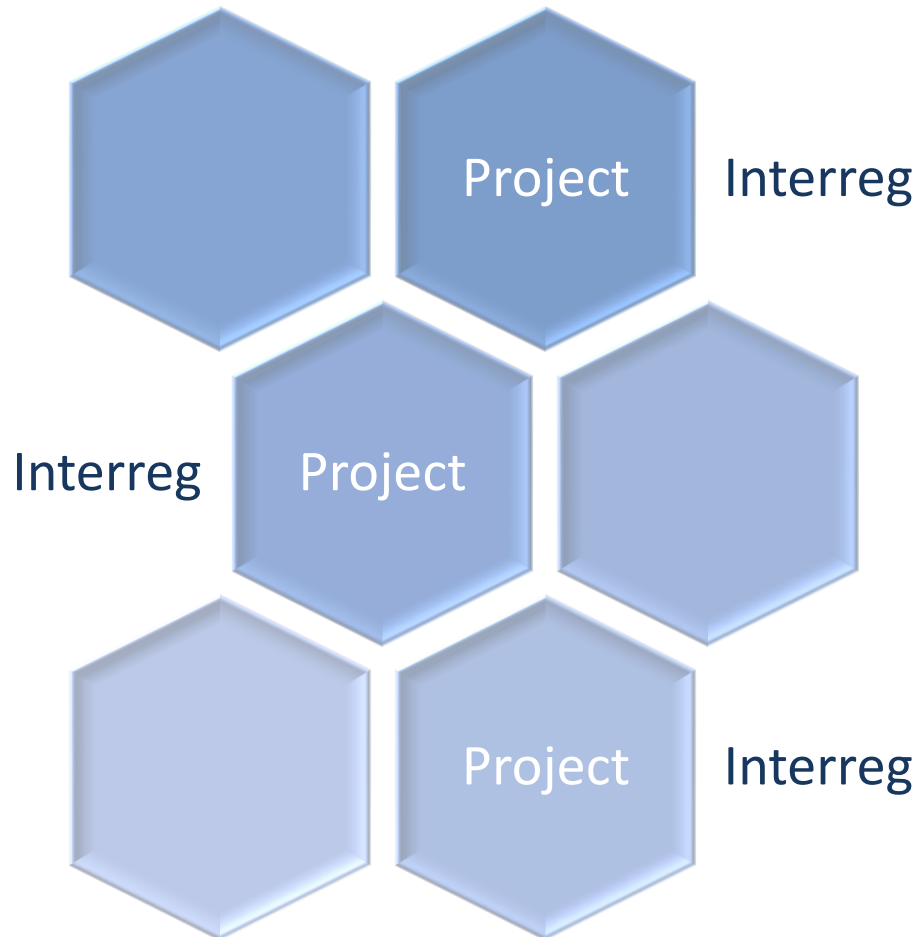

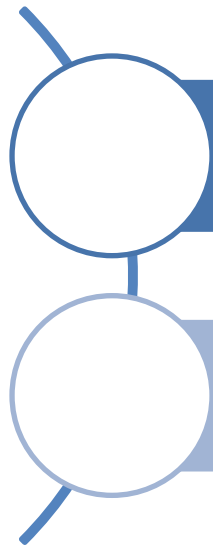

818 projects approved in five transnational programmes and IE



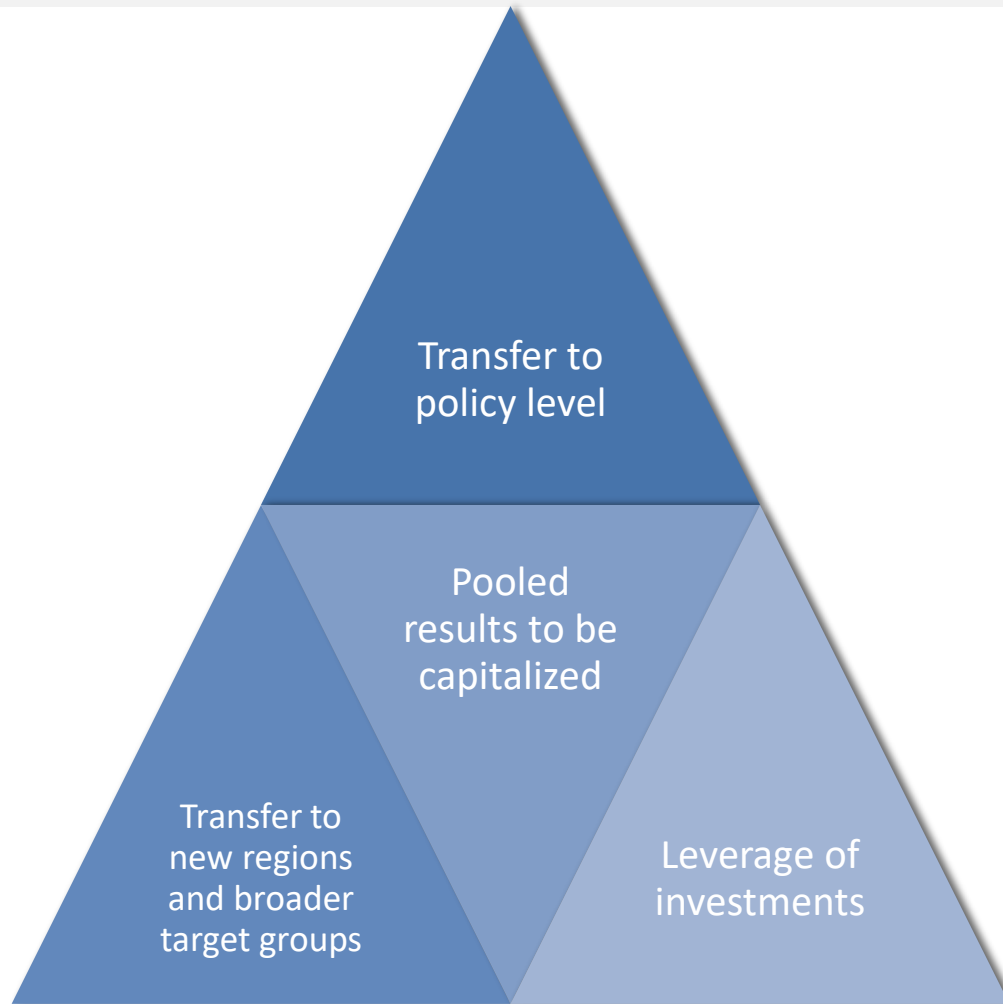

Transfer of knowledge and joint solutions at different levels of capitalization

Objective: from project results to long-lasting processes



Different levels of capitalization

At the level of

- Project or a group of projects
- Geographical area or a type of area
- Programme
- Among Interreg programmes
- With other programmes and initiatives at the European level

... in order to:

- Transfer knowledge into new regions and to institutions within thematic communities
- Reuse or enhance the use of new solutions
- Produce new or improved results based on synergies
- Effectively communicate the achieved results

Leading thought: from projects to thematic communities and processes

Transnational and interregional programmes are becoming more mature: from implementing a large number of projects to building thematic communities and developing processes

The process of capitalization links together thematically similar projects, institutions, programmes, and representatives of strategies and initiatives

Systematically support MR strategies and put effort into harmonizing the functioning of national and regional administrations, as well as relevant actors, taking into account larger functional areas

Project results may be transferred to policy level, new regions and broader target groups, as well as the investment programmes
